

Melva Ruth Hughbanks, age 103, of Elwood, Nebraska, passed away on Wednesday, March 1, 2023 at Elwood Care Center, Elwood, Nebraska. She was born to James and Alice (Musser) Pierce on April 11, 1919 on a farm north of Overton, Nebraska. She was the 5th child of 7 children.

She graduated from Overton High School in 1937. After graduating, she worked at the Minute Man Café and for Tom Dorwort as a nanny. On July 19, 1942, she married Floyd Hughbanks. She was employed at Omaha Cold Storage in Lexington as a clerk. She and Floyd worked on the runway at the Kearney Airport the first year they were married.

In 1958 the family bought and moved to a farm located East of Elwood.

Melva was an avid gardener, both flowers and vegetable gardens. She did oil painting, was a wonderful seamstress, making most of her own clothing. She was very active in the community, PTA chairman, 4-H leader, member of the Flower Club in Lexington. At the age of 89 she began piecing quilts. By the time she was 96 she had finished 25. She finished one quilt that she started when she was a little girl with her grandmother and quilted this herself.
